
When they start at IÉSEG, students become part of IÉSEG Network! And it's a network that continues and evolves after they graduate.

IÉSEG Network's main aim is to be an extensive and diverse resource, closely reflecting the professional concerns of graduates, to help and support them from the moment they leave the School and throughout their professional career.

The careers service approach is structured around five themes:

DISCOVER YOURSELF



Graduates can take stock of their career, develop their self-awareness or solve a specific problem thanks to a free one-and-a-half-hour coaching session with our certified career / executive coach.

Coaching, in a caring and respectful environment, helps to open up new horizons, drawing on strengths and focusing on areas of improvement while overcoming any difficulties and identifying actions needed to give them a boost in their future career. In 2019, IÉSEG Network added **StrengthsFinder®** coaching, an innovative tool that allows alumni to identify and develop their natural talents to increase performance and enjoyment at work.

Finally, **MBTI®** personality profile is an additional resource proposed to alumni to increase their self-awareness, improve their inter-personal communication and be more efficient.

REINVENT YOURSELF



Our **interactive themed workshops** use an experiential style of learning. Grounded in team dynamics, participants benefit from the different perspectives and profiles of fellow graduates to guarantee a variety of new skills and practical applications at the end of the workshop. In just a few hours, the diversity of our workshops teaches participants to improve their awareness, think outside the box and improve their performance.

Our **Back to IÉSEG** program also offers alumni the chance to update their knowledge and increase their employability by returning to IÉSEG to take a course of their choice (at Masters level).

BE OPEN-MINDED

Whether they be young graduates or experienced managers, alumni sometimes go through a questioning phase where their objective change according to their profiles and needs. Using our **mentoring** service and signing up for a mentor/mentee relationship means they can benefit from the experience of someone who is an expert in a subject, take a step back to look a situation from a different angle and develop their ability to tackle an issue and make a decision...



BE INSPIRED

Throughout the year, IÉSEG Network offers evening conferences on major economic and social themes or environmental news as well as **lunchtime webinars** (online seminars) on specific topics of the day.

Hosted by prestigious professional speakers and experts in their field, these conferences and webinars are open to everyone. The webinars are also available for replay at the media centre on the IÉSEG Network website.



To support graduates in their jobs, in their hunt for work or in a change of career, the IÉSEG Network **CareerHUB** offers a wide range of services:

- The CAP 361 program: a co-development group based on five meetings to boost confidence and prepare for the next stage of their professional life
- Career workshops to develop their professional interests and help them make a plan
- Career coaching sessions to reflect in depth on their career
- Advice sessions on career development to master job search tools, perform interview simulations, refine their network approach, etc.
- A platform for job offers



IÉSEG NETWORK CARAVAN

Launched in September 2018, this touring initiative was set up to provide greater proximity between IÉSEG Network and its graduates based all over Europe or in the French provinces. IÉSEG Network goes out to meet them in their city to offer face-to-face coaching and other services related to professional and personal development.
