PURPOSE OF THE CONTEST

The purpose of the contest is to inspire Singapore students interested in studying in France by sharing the experience of members of France Alumni Singapore.

Example of content

- A memory of your stay in France through a training or an internship you would like to share: a major event, a beautiful meeting, a cultural discovery;
- Your experience of study in France;
- Your experience of the French life;
- How does this experience shaped your goals, both personal and professional;

Example of format for your sharing experienced

- A video where you will be filming yourself talking about your French experience;
- A video clip made of your best photos with a music, representing your French experience:
- An animated presentation (PowerPoint, Prezi, flash) made by you and that you comment with subtitles or voice over.

RULES

All participants in the "I studied in France- Alumni contest" agree to comply unconditionally with all the provisions specified in the rules below. Anyone who does not comply with these rules will be considered ineligible for participation.

The Institut Français Singapour (IFS) of the French Embassy and Campus France Singapore reserve the right, at their sole discretion, to refuse and remove any video or text, in whole or in part, that violates these rules or that is otherwise unlawful and objectionable.

Timeline

- 1. 15 January 2017, midnight: deadline for video clip submissions;
- 2. 23 January 2017: publication of the results.

Eligibility

- 1. The "I studied in France- Alumni contest" is open only to individuals who are legal residents in Singapore and are members of the France Alumni Singapore platform:
- 2. Participants must be 18 years of age or older at the time of entry;
- 3. A valid email address is required to participate;
- 4. A France Alumni Singapore completed profile is required to participate.









How to participate

- 1. Eligible individuals may enter the contest by creating and submitting a video-clip up to one
- 2. Participants can submit only one production;
- 3. Participants may submit their production by using the free service We Transfer to the email address study (at) ambafrance-sg.org;
- 4. Participants must send to the following address study (at) ambafrance-sg.org the authorisation document signed:
- 5. Once the production is sent, the entry is final and may not be modified, supplemented or edited.

Entry requirements

- 1. Entries must be in English or French;
- 2. Videos cannot exceed one minute. The acceptable formats for video files are MP4 and MOV. The video must be named by your name;
- 3. Participants shall not modify, exploit, create derivative works, or otherwise interfere with the production submitted by other participants;
- 4. Entries must not infringe upon the intellectual property, privacy, publicity rights, or any other legal/moral rights of any third party;
- 5. Entries must not contain material that is unlawful, in violation of or contrary to the laws or regulations in any state where the video is created;
- 6. Entries must not contain texts or images that are inappropriate, indecent, obscene, hateful, tortuous, defamatory, slanderous, or libellous; or contain texts or images that promote bigotry, racism, hatred, or harm against any group or individual or promote discrimination based on race, gender, religion, nationality, disability, sexual orientation or age;
- 7. Entries must not contain obscenity, explicit sexual material, nudity, profanity, graphic violence, calls to or incitement of violence, commercial solicitation or commercial promotion;
- 8. Entries must not contain content or images that could be considered abusive, inflammatory, denigrating, or disrespectful to France, the French Embassy, or to any other groups, individuals or institutions:
- 9. Entries may not contain brand names or trademarks;
- 10. Entries may not contain copyright material without necessary authorizations;
- 11. By submitting an entry to the contest, the participant affirms that he or she has obtained written consent from all individuals whose image or likeness appears in the video and that he or she has obtained the necessary rights, licenses, consents, and permissions to use all material such as music, images, text and other content in the submission.

Winners' selection

There will be two winners for this contest, selected by the French Embassy.
