Context:

Under the overall supervision of the Chief of Mission of IOM Algeria and direct supervision of the Migration Health Officer and in close coordination with the medical team members, the successful candidate will support the mission through the following duties and responsibilities.

Core Functions / Responsibilities:

- 1. Assist IOM Medical team with filing of health-related documents.
- 2. Help IOM medical team to answer the migrants' requests for health assistance, including those housed at IOM transit centres (DARVs);
- 3. Assist with scheduling health appointment with specialised services and accompany migrants for their appointments as requested;
- 4. Assist the IOM medical team with organizing FFTs (fitness for travel) medical check, including PCR testing and TB screening;
- 5. Provide information to the migrants in relation to the migration health assessment process, treatments, and referrals as well as migration health promotion;
- 6. Assist with organizing counselling and awareness raising sessions to migrants or refugees on COVID-19, TB, HIV and health related topics education, prevention, and management as appropriate;

7. Cooperate with the project team with regard to updating information on the basis of inquiries from beneficiaries;

Perform other duties as may be assigned

Required Qualifications and Experience

• Bachelor's Degree in health science, nursing, caregiver, medical or public health school or a related field from an accredited academic institution

Experience

- Experience in humanitarian work, including volunteer assignments, preferably with migrants an advantage.
- Experience in focused and solution-oriented communication within a sensitive, multicultural and rapidly changing environment.
- Know-how of basic statistical tools for data processing and visualization purposes is an advantage.

Languages

- Fluency in Arabic and French is required.
- Working knowledge of English is an advantage.
