

#### WHAT IS FRANCOPHONIE?

The term Francophonie appeared for the first time around 1880, when a French geographer, Onesime Reclus, used it to designate all people and countries speaking French. We now speak of francophonie with a lowercase "f" to designate the French speakers. The term "Francophonie" with a capital "F" however, is to figure the institutional mechanism organizing relations between Francophone countries.

#### **274 MILLION SPEAKERS**

First, the Francophonie is foremost women and men who share a common language such as French. The latest report of the Observatory of the French language, published in 2014, estimates their number at 274 million speakers on five continents.

#### WHAT IS THE FRANCOPHONE UNIVERSITY FAIR?

The Francophone University Fair in Baku was created in 2018 on the initiative of the French Embassy in Azerbaijan and in partnership with the embassies of several member or observer countries of the International Organization of La Francophonie (OIF) such as Morocco, Romania, Moldova, Hungary and Azerbaijan. This key event the "Weeks of La Francophonie in Azerbaijan" aims to promote the learning of French by presenting the French-language opportunities in terms of trainings offered at participating universities.

This new concept is unheard of in the French-speaking university area and was welcomed by all participants, by the students and the French operator of academic mobility Campus France. It helps to strengthen a Francophone university exchange, in accordance with the objectives of the OIF and the Francophone University Agency (AUF).

The 2nd edition of the Francophone University Fair (SUF) will take place on Sunday, April 07, 2019, from 10am to 5pm in the new premises of UFAZ (French-Azerbaijani University). The attendance in the event as an exhibitor and lecturer is free of charge and it requires a prior registration.


