

Launch of PHC Bosphorus 2019 Joint Project Proposal Call

The PHC Bosphorus is the Hubert Curien Partnership between France and Turkey. It is implemented by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of France, the Ministry of Higher Education, Research and Innovation of France and the Scientific and Technological Research Council of Turkey, TÜBİTAK.

The aim of this program is to develop scientific and technological partnerships between research centres of the two countries, enhancing new cooperation.

This program is open to all scientific fields, including social sciences and humanities. Nevertheless, priority is given to the following fields:

- Security, including disaster resilience and fight against terrorism
- Transports, including aeronautics
- Space
- Mathematics
- Information and communication technologies, including digital security
- Material sciences, including nanotechnologies
- Environmental sciences, including seismic studies
- Biotechnologies, with special emphasis on health and agricultural applications
- Energy studies, including renewable and nuclear energies

Deadline for submission: 18th June 2018

Publication of results: December 2018

Beginning of projects: January 2019
